NEW ROADS AND STREETWORKS ACT 1991 - Supervisor

The Aim of the Course is to:

Enable Supervisors to gain the necessary qualifications (*Up to 5 groups can be gained*) under the New roads and Streetworks Act 1991 to allow them to carry out their duties on the public highway, ranging from excavation to permanent re-instatement of paved structures.

The Objectives of the Course are to enable delegates to:

- Gain skills and knowledge to fulfil duties required by the Roads and Streets Works Act 1991.
- Be able to supervise operatives to ensure that the quality of re-instatement etc. meets with the required standards.
- Have an understanding of responsibilities under Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 & other current relevant legislation.

Who Should Attend The Course?

To comply with the law there must be a qualified supervisor available to supervise in the aspect of the work being undertaken.
