If the works do not involve breaking up the road or are works only of the type referred to in regulation 3(2), a trained operative has a prescribed qualification if he has achieved the unit of competence set out as Unit 2.

It is therefore advisable that candidates who are completing Unit 10 should also complete Unit 2 so that they have a qualification that ensures compliance with the law.
