



In and Around Our Training Centre

The key focus of Sibbald Training is to safeguard the health, safety and wellbeing of all persons using our facilities. At present we are seeing governmental shift away from formal COVID restrictions, however the possibility of being affected by this virus remains a very real possibility, therefore Sibbald Training are committed to maintaining the controls listed below, to maximise the protection of all those persons who are actively utilising our facilities on a daily basis. It is our intention to remain vigilant and keep our precautions in line with Scottish government guidance, although where necessary, we may retain a more stringent regime, maintaining our excellent high standards minimising the risk of COVID transmission at the Sibbald centre.

- All persons using the Sibbald centre must respect social distancing of 1 metre, where possible.
- All persons, whilst on their feet are expected to wear a face covering unless they have a medical exemption.
- Face masks are available to any candidates who request them.
- All persons must maintain good levels of personal hygiene, by washing and sanitising hands on a regular basis and especially after the use of the toilet facilities.
- Toilet facilities have restricted maximum numbers.
- Sanitiser is situated throughout the training centre, including classrooms.
- Lunches will remain being delivered to the classrooms to minimise social contact in public spaces.
- Tea urns are set up in each classroom with disposable spoons, paper cups and single sachets for sugar, milk etc
- All areas of the training centre are deep cleaned each evening and toilets twice each day, or more if the need arises.
- The induction at the start of any training course includes our up-to-date COVID rules.

We request that all persons who attend the Sibbald centre, this includes our instructors, take lateral flow tests to determine their status with regards to COVID and anyone who tests positive must inform us as soon as they can and avoid attendance.
