Aims

This course outlines current legislation, regulations and guidance affecting work at height using mobile access towers

Who Attends

This course is designed for those who have responsibility for overseeing the work of operatives on site ensuring that work is properly planned and organised.

It establishes that those involved in carrying out the work are competent and properly trained, and that towers are correctly inspected and maintained.
