Aims

This industry leading course will provide delegates with the knowledge and practical skills to safely operate powered access equipment. This IPAF Operator course with practical training session and assessment covers one powered access product – Static Boom (1b).

Who Attends

Delegates who use, supervise or manage the use of powered access, self-propelled boom lifts (outriggers), trailer/ push-arounds and vehicle mounted platforms.

Qualification Obtained
