



RTITB Counterbalanced Lift Truck

Aims

This course is designed to train and assess operators in the safe operation of a counterbalance lift truck.

Those attending will gain insight and knowledge on the safe use of Rider-operated Lift Trucks. By the end of the course, candidates will be able to identify main components of the Lift Truck, operate the machine safely to a high standard in the working environment and understand current Legislation.

Who Attends

Novice lift truck operators with no training on forklifts.

- PUWER 98 (Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 98)
- LOLER 98 (Lifting Operations and Lift Equipment Regulations 98)
- L117 - Rider-operated lift trucks (ACOP & Guidance)
- Care of Batteries/Diesel/LPG trucks
- Lifting Principals
- Stability factors
- Principals of counterbalance fork lift trucks
- Steering operations - forward & reverse
- Steering operations in confined areas
- Pallet handling; picking up, setting down, transporting
- Stacking and de-stacking loads at different heights (Various methods)
- Vehicle loading & un-loading procedures
- Daily maintenance checks
- Satisfactory completion of Practical and Theory based assessment

Course Duration

This is a 5 day course which includes training and testing.
