



CPC ICRS30148 - Route Planning and Fuel Efficiency

Aims

The intention of this course is to modernise driving methods. It introduces route planning applications. Every driver of a Large Goods Vehicle, who is driving for financial gain (a job!) - must, by law, train for 35 hours (that's 5 days), every 5 years. This course is designed to provide 7 hours of this training towards the 35 hours total required.

Who Attends

Candidates must hold a current valid Professional Driving Licence.

Course Content

- Detailing the use of Satellite Navigation systems and the problems Professional Drivers face using them
- Low bridge issues
- Planning routes exercise using the EU and WTD regulations.
- Driver's part in fuel economy
- Advice given on best techniques to obtain the most from modern vehicle technology

Course Duration

This is a 1 day course.

Qualification Obtained

Seven (7) hours added to the candidates Professional Driver record.
